








Child Care Use: By Type, Across Age




Publicly-Funded Center-Based



- Serves families below the federal poverty line & children with disabilities.
- Prenatal to 5 years old
 - 78% enrolled are between ages 3 and 5.








Child Care Use: By Type, Across Age

- Family Child Care Home
- Licensed Child Care Home
- Licensed Group Family Child Care Home
- Legally or License-Exempt Home
- Certified Child Care Home
- Registered Child Care
 Home
- Family, Friend and Neighbor (FFN) Care

2012 7.7 million 0-5 year-olds in 3.8 million homes



- May or may not be required to follow health and safety standards.
 - Standards may be set by state/county/city.





- May or may not be required to follow health and safety standards.
 - Standards may be set by state/county/city.
 - Often depends upon number of unrelated children provider cares for.





- If they are required to meet standards, they may be called:
 - Regulated, Licensed,
 Registered, or
 Certified.






- Licensed-exempt providers:
 - Family, Friend, and
 Neighbor Care
- Not regulated care:
 Informal Child Care






- Unregulated form of child care in or out of family's home.
- Across all ages 0-5, 60% of home-based care is unpaid





Common Combinations of Care





Center & Home Unpaid: 7.5%

Home Paid & Unpaid: 2.3%

Irregular: 7.4%

Center & Home Unpaid: 2.0%
